## Glendale Park RFQ Questions and Answers

## 1. Answered 4/12/2019

<u>Question:</u> I read through the complete RFQ, and did not see anything regarding the size of the project. Is there a size restriction or preference the Salt Lake Art Design Board, Community Stakeholders, and/ or the Design and Construction Teams would wish for?

<u>Answer:</u> For clarification, this call for artists is in the form of an RFQ, request for qualifications, so we will not be reviewing proposals at this time. We will review the artist's letter of interest, resume, references, and images of completed past work of similar scope and scale.

The Art Design Board will select one artist and an alternate. The selected artist will be invited to develop a proposal and to work closely with the architecture consultant. The Artist has the opportunity to decide how their artwork is incorporated into the park, whether it is a free standing sculpture, integrated into the design elements, etc. At this time, there are no restrictions for size, or preferences, although we will expect the final artwork to respond to the artwork goals.

## 2. Answered 4/24/2019

<u>Question:</u> It mentions that you have contracted with a landscape architect / design describes these changes?

<u>Answer:</u> Yes, currently there is a site plan that is at about 40% design. We've attached the site plan in the RFQ for artists to be able to view where design is currently at. The site plans will not change until an artist is selected to further develop site details with the landscape and design team.
