Fairmont Park & McClelland Shared Trail

Questions are listed in the order they are received. If you do not see the answer to your question here or in the full [Request for Qualifications](#), you may submit questions by email to publicartprogram@slc.gov.

- **Is the project requesting a single piece of art or artworks at multiple locations?**
Yes. This commission will involve multiple components along McClelland Shared Street and Fairmont Park.
- **Are there any restrictions on the maximum height of any component of the art piece?**
Final height considerations will be addressed during the finalist proposal stage. Artists must comply with all applicable Salt Lake City codes and ordinances. Artwork size will also need to align with the available budget.
- **Will the S-Line train line be extending further east?**
Yes, the S-Line is planned for extension. This transportation project is separate from this public art commission. More information is available on [UTA's project page](#).
- **Are there any projects happening now inside Fairmont Park?**
Yes. Public Lands has entered the final conceptual design phase for the [Fairmont Park Improvement Project](#). The selected artist/team and their concepts will be incorporated into this design phase.
- **For eligibility, does an artist/team need prior experience with a project of equal or greater budget and scale, or is demonstrated growth acceptable?**
The Art Design Board and project stakeholders will look for experience relevant to the scope of this project. This may include comparable budgets, working across multiple sites, or participation in larger interdisciplinary design teams where artwork was integrated into a broader site or landscape project.
